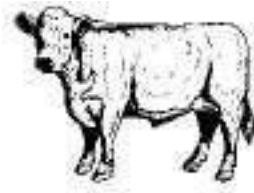

Lot 13-Breeders Herd, three breeding animals owned by the same exhibitor

Lot 14-Market Steer, born after Jan. 1 previous year and weighing a minimum of 1,050 lbs. and maximum payable weight of 1,400 lbs. Steers will be divided into market class according to weight (light to heavy weight). All entries must be entered into Lot 16 Market Steer Carcass Contest. Entry and photo of market animal with tag #showing must be sent to email address or postmarked by July 6, 2018. Please send photo and entry together either via email (pdf file for entry) or US Mail.

Lot 15- Feeder Market Steer (steers weighing less than 1050 lbs and born in previous year)

Lot 16- Market Steer Carcass Contest, animals must be cross entered in Lot 14, make weight at fair and sell to be slaughtered by resale buyer (Tyson) or a Baker City butcher that will butcher in time for grading to be made. Animals taken home by buyer or butchered elsewhere will not be eligible because of practicalities related to grading. Placing is determined with criteria established by the Oregon Carcass Steer of Merit Program as revised March 2009. If data results in a tie, Livestock superintendent will be responsible for forming a committee of three local knowledgeable individuals to resolve tie. The committee's decision will be final. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place prize to be awarded

Lot 17-Beef Showmanship Note: you must show in showmanship to sell a market animal

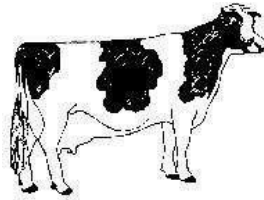

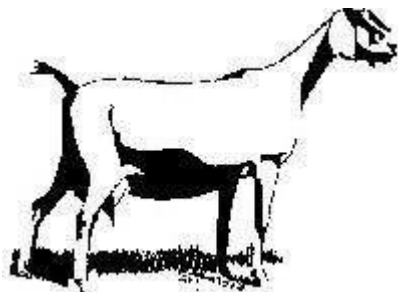

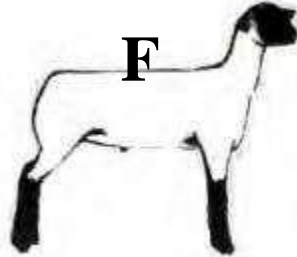

SMALL ANIMALS GUIDELINES AND RULES

1. Market rabbits, chickens and turkeys will be weighed in between 5:00 pm and 8:00 pm Friday
2. Rabbit showmanship will begin at 8:00 a.m. Sunday morning followed by poultry showmanship.
3. Animals will be judged according to breed and variety. Exhibitors may enter up to 5 animals of different breeds per lot. Must arrange for sufficient handlers so that each animal has a handler.
4. Any animal having a permanent defect will be placed in the white ribbon group. Any animal that has a correctable problem shall be placed in the red and white ribbon group at the judge's discretion.
5. All small animals' health will be checked before penning. Any small animal found to have a communicable disease, parasites (including earmites) must be removed from the grounds immediately and will not be allowed to show.
6. Animals must have water in their pens at all times.
7. No premium for market animals.
